

## 2019 PINOT GRIS

MONTEREY COUNTY

Since 1980, the Hahn family has cultivated their hillside vineyards in Monterey County. Today, Hahn wines represent the family's commitment to craft rich, supple wines which over deliver on quality yet are perfect for everyday enjoyment.

WINEMAKING NOTES: This Pinot Gris hails from vineyards in Monterey County, where cool breezes from the Pacific Ocean slow down ripening and extend hang times. These conditions produce vibrant flavor and highlight the varietal's brisk acidity. Once harvested, the grapes for this wine were fermented in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks. The cool fermentation preserved the variety's delicate floral and stone fruit aromas, resulting in a bright, refreshing finish.

**TASTING NOTES:** Aromas of pears and sliced apples are accompanied by hints of lime and grapefruit blossom. The palate is bright, with flavors of pear, apple and lime, finishing with round acidity.
