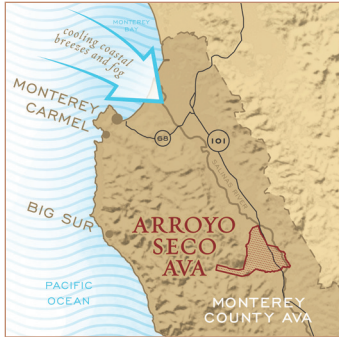

The Hahns established their namesake winery nestled in the majestic hills of Monterey County in 1980. Today, the family still owns the winery and farms its six certified sustainable estate vineyards. Each wine is grown, selectively harvested and produced to express vibrant yet integrated fruit flavors and balanced acidity to complement and enhance a variety of foods.

VINEYARDS

Grapes for this wine are sourced from Ste. Philippe vineyard – our certified sustainable estate vineyard in the Arroyo Seco appellation of Monterey County. Located south of the Santa Lucia Highlands, the Ste. Philippe vineyard sits in an ancient, dry riverbed with well-drained, sandy-loam soils. Arroyo Seco river stones, also known as “Greenfield Potatoes,” named for the adjacent town of Greenfield, CA, are unique to this region and integral to the soil as they store and release heat. Coastal influence and cool winds from Monterey Bay contribute to an extended growing season which ensures complexity and intensity of the fruit.

WINEMAKING

Picked in early morning, the Pinot Noir grapes were destemmed into stainless steel tanks and fermented for about 3 weeks. During that time, the wine was gently punched down several times daily to maximize color, aromatics and flavor extraction. After the juice was pressed off the skins, it was settled and raked into French oak barrels for 11 months of aging.

TASTING NOTES

Clear red ruby in color with aromas of red cherry, ripe raspberry, toasted oak and subtle hints of roasted coffee. On the palate, soft and delicate flavors of cherry, red fruit and vanilla followed by a touch of spice on a long finish.
